What is Spirit, Body and Soul

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Understanding the Soul

In expounding on the makeup of the soul, Joe crews of Amazingfacts.org compares the soul, body and spirit to the makeup of a wooden box. If you have a set of wooden planks and a set of nails and combine the two components you get a wooden box. If you separate the nails and the planks what would happen to the box? The box is no more! It is only when you combine the two components that you wind up with a complete box:

Wooden Box = planks + nails

A body combined with a spirit gives rise to a living soul.

Soul = body + spirit

A more modernized illustration is presented by Doug Batchelor of AmazingFacts.org. When you combine a computer box with a hard drive you wind up with a functioning Personal Computer (PC). If you separate the computer housing from the hard drive well, the PC is no more.

PC = box + hard drive

In a similar fashion a living soul is a body combined with a spirit.

Soul = body + spirit

Expanding on this and adding one final element, electricity, you end up with a complete solution:

Working PC = box + hard drive + electricity

A Living Soul = body + spirit + breath

What happens to you when you die?

When a person dies their body decomposes and their spirit is retained by God who gave it. Their soul - composed of body & spirit & breath - ceases to exist.

Ecclesiastes 12:7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Acts 7:59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

In this way your spirit serves to restore your soul. Adding a physical or spiritual body and the breath of life is all that is needed for you to regain your conscious thought. Your spirit is YOU and serves as a case file (or rap sheet) at the judgment to ensure that YOU - and not a COPY of you - are held accountable to pay for your sins, evil deeds and crimes against humanity.

Luke 8:53 And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead. 54 And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise. 55 And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.

1 Corinthians 15:44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

Genesis 6:3 ¶And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

John 5:28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

The Four Laws

Working PC = box + hard drive + electricity

If the box (pc housing) is destroyed the PC ceases to function <u>but</u> you can get a new box. If the electricity is cut off the PC ceases to function <u>but</u> you can get a new power source. If the hard drive is destroyed & the data lost then the PC is <u>dead</u> and cannot be recovered. If the PC in its entirety is destroyed then the PC is <u>dead</u> and cannot be recovered.

*The hard drive thus serves as the most important component in the makeup of a complete PC

The Four Laws

Living Soul = body + breath + spirit.

If the body is destroyed the Soul ceases to function <u>but</u> you can get a new body. If the breath is lost the Soul ceases to function <u>but</u> you can get new breath. If the spirit is completely destroyed the Soul is <u>dead</u> and cannot be recovered. If the Soul in its entirety is destroyed the Soul is <u>dead</u> and cannot be recovered.

*The spirit thus serves as the most important component in the makeup of the Soul Footnote: spirit and breath are sometimes viewed as synonymous.

The Four Stages of Life

1) First Death

Is the normal death that everyone undergoes. At this stage your body dies, your breath ceases and your spirit returns to God - your soul ceases to exist.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

2) First Resurrection

At the time of the Son's return those who are dead 'in Christ' rise first and, along with those who are still alive and qualify, are caught up like helium balloons to meet Him in the air. This resurrection belongs to those who perform extraordinary feats in their service towards the kingdom of God.

Thessalonians 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. 16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: 17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

These individuals are the chosen few who rule with the Son for a thousand years. They are the "made men" or the "untouchables".

Revelation 20:6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

The return of the Son and the first resurrection, generally referred to as the 'Second Coming' or the 'rapture', leads into the thousand year rulership, often referred to as the 'millennium'. This is when the 'smart people' govern the earth.

So, you want a government job?

-: What does it take to qualify?

 Well, if you managed to spread the good news of God's kingdom throughout the entire earth in a very short space of time you'd certainly be a very strong candidate.
Or, if you fed the poor and needy around the world for the next few years you'd demonstrably be a very viable candidate.

3) You must be 'in Christ'. And what does that mean? Read below:

Colossians 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. 3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory. 5 ¶Mortify therefore your members which are upon the

earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: 6 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience: 7 In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them. 8 ¶But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. 9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; 10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

-: What are the perks?

 You get to rule over the nations of the earth for a thousand years.
The real perk though is that you can never be judged and therefore stand absolutely no chance of ending up in the lake of fire. So if you have a strong aversion to ending up there you might want to seriously consider striving toward this goal.

Revelation 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

Revelation 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Revelation 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

-: Who are the candidates?

When looking for candidates to fill these positions one could consider such individuals as Joe Crews of Amazingfacts.org... or how about Billy Graham? At the end of the day it is the Son who decides on these saintly individuals.

Revelation 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, 6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; 10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

-: Whom will you rule?

As occurred at the time of the flood, those who survive through the flood of fire of the Second Coming [a minimum of eight would actually suffice] will live on the earth. So some of the generation alive at the time of that event will survive into the 'Golden Age' making up the nations of the world.

Matthew 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. 38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, 39 And knew not until the flood came, and **took them all away**; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. **Matthew 24:40** Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be **taken**, and the other left. 41 Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be **taken**, and the other left. 42 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

Luke 17:28 Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded; 29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all.

2 Peter 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

-: What are the conditions on the earth?

With the Son reigning the nations and Satan locked away there is a thousand years of relative calm on the earth.

Revelation 20:1 ¶And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

The Last [two] Days, the age in which man is currently living, comes to a close and the Son of God re-emerges on the Third Day - which is the 'Last Day' or 'Seventh Day' - the 'Sabbath Day'. With the Advent of the Seventh Day the earth is culled of the wicked, the 'smart people' take over ruler-ship over the earth in a Divine Monarchy and the meek inherit the resources of the earth. This period of a thousand years of calm is the period in which the earth gets to rest from its woes.

2 Peter 3:3 ¶Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, 4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.

2 Peter 3:8 (But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

Exodus 20:8 Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. 9 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: 10 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: 11 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

Luke 6:1 ¶And it came to pass on the second sabbath after the first, that he went through the corn fields; and his disciples plucked the ears of corn, and did eat, rubbing them in their hands. 2 And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath days? 3 And Jesus answering them said, Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungred, and they which were with him; 4 How he went into the house of God, and did take and eat the shewbread, and gave also to them that were with him; which it is not lawful to eat but for the priests alone? 5 And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

3) Second Resurrection The rest of mankind who lived on earth before the 'Second Coming' occurs and failed to gain the 'First Resurrection' will by default obtain the 'Second Resurrection' when the thousand years of theocratic rule on earth eventually comes to a close and all who make up the rest of the dead are brought back to life.

Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Before this occurs though the thousand years of theocratic rule - which may have passed you by - ends with the release of Satan when the last generation of super kids living on earth at that time are put to the test by him.

Revelation 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. 9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. 10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

See yah!

So if you lived 'outside of Christ' or failed to make the grade and totally missed the opportunity to gain the "free pass" offered to the redeemed at the 'First Resurrection', you still have an opportunity to obtain a "normal pass"; if you're judged worthy at the 'Second Resurrection'.

All of the individuals who lived on the earth come to life to face judgment (except of course for the 'untouchables' who are alive and were ruling with the Son) to see if they are judged worthy according to the works they've done against the principles laid down in a set of books that are opened. There are thus a set of universal moral laws in existence that regulate the conduct of men and women and reflect the mind and character of God Himself. If you are judged worthy according to your works your name is added to the book of life and you have attained the resurrection of the just.

Mark 6:11 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.

Luke 11:32 The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

Luke 11:31 The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here.

Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Romans 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified. 14 For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves: 15 Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

Acts 24:15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Matthew 13:49 So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just, 50 And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. 51 Jesus saith unto them, Have ye understood all these things? They say unto him, Yea, Lord.

As you are judged according to your works: whether or not you made a sincere and valid attempt to do good works or uphold godly values or how you treated others, etc. you have a deliberate opportunity to actively do good works before your curtain falls and - the shows over folks. If you also assist or do good to those who are 'in Christ' it counts in your favor.

James 1:27 Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

Luke 14:12 Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor thy rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompence be made thee. 13 But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind: 14 And thou shalt be blessed; for they cannot recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the resurrection of the just.

Mark 9:41 ¶For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reward.

Revelation 3:15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. 16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. 17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

Matthew 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: 33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. 34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: 35 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: 36 Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was

in prison, and ye came unto me. 37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? 38 When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? 39 Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? 40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

If you are flatly unbelieving or basically just a troublesome lad then you are literally playing with fire and are at risk of squandering your salvation and are in danger of heading towards the resurrection of the unjust.

Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand. Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: 42 For I was an hungred, and ye gave me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me no drink: 43 I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not. 44 Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? 45 Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me. 46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

If you feel that you are simply incapable of making the grade and gaining the resurrection of the just - there is yet one thing that you could possibly do to avoid ending up in the lake of fire:

Matthew 18:6 But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me. it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Perhaps, they won't find you there.

If you have absolutely no interest in any of the above then you can do whatever it is you wish. As long as you keep just one thing in mind:

Burn Koreve

Don't do the crime, if you can't do the time.

4) Second Death The Second Death is the lake of fire. The lake of fire, originally prepared for the devil and his angels, is a spiritual incinerator where unworthy elements and concepts are disposed of. Here is a list of things you might want to chuck into the lake of fire: (No, your mother-in-law or ex-husband are not automatic options)

> liars the devil and his angels death hell (the grave)

the wicked unbelievers hypocrites: covetous men

unrighteous souls idolaters murderers the abominable

Hell**1** : Is associated with the First Death and is the grave Hell2 : Is associated with the Second Death and is the lake of fire



Revelation 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Irrespective of what you deem the lake of fire to actually be - you may not want your five brothers to end up there:

Luke 16:27 Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: 28 For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. 29 Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. 30 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. 31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

If you do suffer the Second Death then no retrieval company in the entire universe will be able to bring you back. And your life will have effectively been an unpleasant interruption of nothingness.

Psalms 49:7 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: 8 (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:)
